OVERVIEW:

 As part of a condition of consent, lands have been conveyed to the Township to accommodate road widening requirements.

A By-law is required to dedicate part of Gee Road as a Public Highway.

RECOMMENDATION:

 That, Report RFD PW-01-2016, re: <u>Road Widening-Condition of Consent, 4388</u> <u>Regional Road 20 along Gee Road Land Transfer Declaration as a Public Highway</u> dated January 18, 2016 be received; and,

2. That, a By-Law be passed to declare Part 2 of Plan No. 30R-14610 on Gee Road as a Public Highway.

ALIGNMENT TO STRATEGIC PLAN:

Key Actions (reference page 29):

1. Explore infrastructure processes and materials to improve the durability of rural roads and bridges and begin to incorporate in future renewal projects

BACKGROUND:

On February 18, 2015, the Committee of Adjustment approved file number B2/2015WL. As part of a condition of consent, it was required that a land transfer for the purposes of a future road widening on Gee Road be provided in accordance with Township Policy POL-PW-1-04.

REPORT:

The land transfer has now been received and confirmed by Staff. As shown on Reference Plan No. 30R-14610 (Attachment 'A') dated October 9, 2015, the lands measuring 4.97 metres by 683.20 metres - (Part 2) have now been transferred. In order to complete the process, Staff is now requesting Council pass a by-law to establish these lands as a Public Highway.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

There is no financial impact to the Township.

INTER-DEPARTMENTAL COMMENTS:

This report has been reviewed by the Clerk's Department.

CONCLUSION:

In summary, Staff recommends that Council pass a by-law dedicating the above mentioned lands as a Public Highway.
