TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE

Weekdays Monday, April 22, 2019 until Tuesday, April 30, 2019

Motorists and the general public are hereby advised that Regional Road 69 (Twenty Mile Road) will be temporarily closed to through traffic between Campden Road and Rosedene Road from Monday, April 22, 2019 to Tuesday, April 30, 2019 weather permitting.

The road closure is necessary for the erection of bridge girders on the new Reece Bridge over Twenty Mile Creek.

The detour route for the closure is as follows:

Regional Road 20 (Highway 20)/Regional Road 24 (Victoria Avenue)

Residents on Twenty Mile Road will have access to their properties east and west of Reece Bridge during the closure but will not be able to cross the existing Reece Bridge during the closure.

Emergency services will be notified of the closure.
