Over Twenty Mile Creek

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE  
Tuesday, September 17, 2019**

Motorists and the general public are hereby advised that Regional Road 69 (Twenty Mile Road) will be temporarily closed to through traffic between Campden Road and Rosedene Road on Tuesday, September 17, 2019, weather permitting.

The road closure is necessary for the final asphalt paving of the deck and road approaches of the new Reece Bridge over Twenty Mile Creek.

**The detour route for the closure is as follows:**

Regional Road 20 (Highway 20)/Regional Road 24 (Victoria Avenue)

Residents on Twenty Mile Road will have access to their properties east and west of Reece Bridge during the closure but will not be able to cross the existing Reece Bridge during the closure.

Emergency services will be notified of the closure.
