

## Notice of the Passing of a By-law to Revise the Ward Boundaries in the Township of West Lincoln

On Monday, December 12, 2016, the Council of the Township of West Lincoln passed By-law 2016-123 pursuant to Section 222 of the Municipal Act 2001 with respect to the re-division of ward boundaries. The purpose of this by-law is to re-divide the existing wards in the Township of West Lincoln to address growth and provide for more equitable and balanced voter representation.

If you object to this decision, you, the Minister or any other person or agency, may appeal the decision to the Ontario Municipal Board (OMB) by filing an appeal, by no later than 4:30 p.m. on January 26, 2017. You must submit letter (Notice of Appeal) to the Clerk of the Township of West Lincoln at the address noted below. Your letter of appeal must set out the objections to the by-law and the reasons in support of the objections, along with a fee of \$300.00 in the form of a certified cheque or money order made payable to the Minister of Finance.

A map showing the revised ward boundaries is provided below. The complete by-law is available for inspection at the Township of West Lincoln at the address noted below during regular business hours, Monday to Friday, 9:00 am to 4:30 pm.
