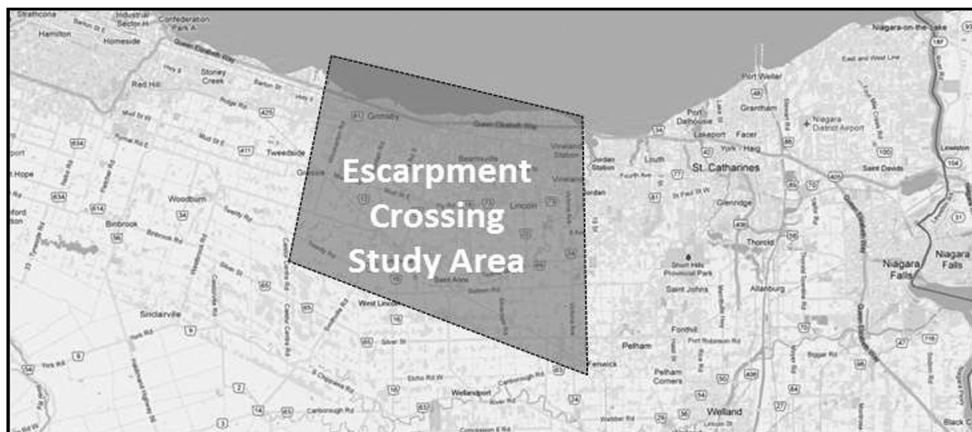


# **Public Information Centre No. 2 Has Been Postponed Niagara Escarpment Crossing Study Class Environmental Assessment**
