Reconstruction of Regional Road 14 (Canborough Street)

From Townline Road to Regional Road 20

In the Township of West Lincoln

Niagara Region will be reconstructing Regional Road 14 (Canborough Street/Griffin Street) which includes the intersection improvement at Regional Road 14 (Griffin Street) and Regional Road 20 (St. Catharine's Street). The project will consist of new curbing, sidewalk, bridge work, landscaping, storm sewer as well as watermain replacement.

This contract will be carried out for the Region by ***Norjohn Contracting and Paving Ltd.***

Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin **mid May 2014** and will be continuous until likely the end of **2014**, weather permitting.

Due to the scope of the work involved, driveway accessibility may be affected during construction. Every effort will be made to give you notice in advance should this occur.

At times, there may be some inconvenience to you during the construction period and I respectfully request your patience and co-operation during this period. If we disturb your property during the construction, we, or our contractor, will carry out the necessary repairs as quickly as possible. With respect to sod restoration, please be advised that the Region's contractor will water the sodded areas immediately after placement. To ensure proper root growth, the property owner is requested to continue to water the newly sodded areas after the initial watering by the Region's contractor.

If you have an irrigation system on the Region's property, you must spray paint, **white paint only**, or stake out the location of your irrigation system within six (6) metres of the roadway. Only irrigation systems which have been correctly located by the property owner and are damaged by the contractor will be repaired. The property owner will be responsible for repairs to any irrigation system on the Region's property that is damaged which has not been previously located by the owner.

The construction inspector will advise you at the beginning of the project if any of your decorative or landscaping items (shrubs, hedges, fences, etc.) **are on the Region's property** and are conflicting with the proposed works. It is requested that the property owners remove/relocate these conflicts that would otherwise be damaged, destroyed or removed and not replaced by the Region to accommodate the proposed works.

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Prior to construction, a representative from **dba Environmental Services Inc.** will be contacting directly affected property owners to arrange for an inspection of the interior and exterior of their building. The purpose of this inspection is to determine and document the extent of any cracking or other damage that exists prior to the commencement of construction. This information can then be used to determine the extent of the contractor's responsibility in the unlikely event that damage to your property occurs during construction.

If you require any accommodations for a disability with respect to accessing your property during service disruptions, please let us know in advance so that arrangements can be made in a timely manner.
